E-130 April 22	District	<i>DISTRICT BOUNDARY CHANGES: § 10522, 10524 & 12262</i> Deadline for district to complete boundary changes in order to comply with the elections code.
E-125 April 27	District	<i>NOTICE OF ELECTION § 10509</i> The district secretary shall deliver to the elections official a notice bearing the secretary's signature and the district seal containing: (a) the offices, if any, to be filled and the balance of an unexpired term, and (b) whether the district or the candidate is to pay for the publication of a statement of qualification.
E-125 April 27	District	<i>BOUNDARY MAPS § 10522</i> The district secretary of a resident voting district shall deliver to the elections official of each affected county a map showing the boundaries of the district and a statement indicating in which divisions a director is to be elected and whether any elective officer is to be elected at large.
E-120 May 2	Registrar of Voters	<i>BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO ADOPT RESOLUTION CALLING THE ELECTION</i>
E- 120 – 90 May 2 – June 1	Registrar of Voters	<i>PUBLISH NOTICE OF ELECTION § 12112, 12113</i> Between these dates, the Registrar of Voters shall publish a notice of election once in a newspaper of general circulation in the district. The notice shall contain the date of the election, name the offices for which candidates may file, and state the qualifications required by the principal act for each office. The notice shall state the location where official declarations of candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for any of the elective offices may be obtained, the office in which completed declarations of candidacy are required to be filed, and the date and time after which no declarations of candidacy may be accepted for filing. A copy of the notice shall be delivered to the district secretary and shall be posted in the district office. <i>GENERAL PRESS RELEASE (E.C. § 12112)</i> Press release must include offices to be filled and telephone numbers for information regarding filing for the elective office.

E-120 May 2	District	<i>LAST DAY TO IMPLEMENT REGULATIONS REGARDING CANDIDATE STATEMENTS (E.C. § 13307)</i> Last day for local agency to implement or amend regulations regarding charges for printing candidate statements.
E-116 May 6	Registrar of Voters	<i>PRECINCTING SECTION TO COMPLETE BOUNDARY CHANGES</i> Precinct section must complete boundary changes by this date.
E-113 – 88 May 9 – June 3	Candidates / District / Registrar of Voters	<i>NOMINATION PERIOD (E.C. §§,10510 ,10602, 13107, 13307, 13309,13311)</i> Between these dates candidates may obtain and file declarations of candidacy. Forms are available at the Registrar of Voters office. All forms must be filed with the Registrar of Voters by the filing deadline. It is the responsibility of each candidate to deliver their nomination documents to the Registrar of Voters by 5:00 p.m. on the deadline date. The ballot designation worksheet must be filed. Candidates who want to file a candidate statement must file it at the same time the Declaration of Candidacy is filed. Candidate Statements are confidential until the deadline for filing has passed. No person shall file nomination documents for more than one district office at the same time.
E-113-88 May 9 – June 3	Candidates / District / Registrar of Voters	<i>CODE OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES</i> Each candidate shall be issued a Code of Fair Campaign Practices. Filing the Code is voluntary and it may be filed with the Registrar of Voters any time prior to the close of nomination. It is public record and available for public inspection.
E-113-88 May 9 – June 3	Candidates / Registrar of Voters	<i>STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC INTEREST (G.C. § 87200 et seq.)</i> A Statement of Economic Interest for all candidates must be filed with the Registrar of Voters by the close of the nomination period.
E-88 June 3	Candidates / Registrar of Voters	<i>LAST DAY TO FILE DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY AND / OR WITHDRAW (E.C. § 13307)</i> Last day for candidates to file their Declarations of Candidacy and Candidate Statements with the Registrar of Voters. Candidate Statements are optional. Candidate must withdraw before 5 p.m., unless there is an extension of the nomination period. <i>PUBLIC EXAM PERIOD (E.C. § 13313)</i> There will be a 10 day exam period for Candidate Statements filed. The period will be held <u>06/03</u> thru <u>06/12</u> .
E88 – E68 June 3 – June 23	Registrar of Voters	<i>DEATH OF A CANDIDATE-GENERAL PROVISIONS(E.C. §§ 10529,15402)</i> If during this period the election official determines a candidate who qualified for the ballot has died, the deceased candidate's name shall not be printed on the ballot. If a candidate dies after the 68 th day before the election, his or her name remains on the ballot. If the deceased candidate wins, the vacancy in the office shall be treated as if that candidate had died after taking office.
E-87 June 4*	Candidates / Registrar of Voters	<i>LAST DAY TO WITHDRAW CANDIDATE STATEMENT (E.C. § 13307)</i> Last day to withdraw candidate statements, unless there is an extension of the nomination period. Withdrawal of candidate

		statements must be in writing.
E-87 June 4*	Registrar of Voters	<i>Random Alphabet Drawing: E.C. § 13113 (a) (3)</i> The Registrar of Voter will notify the Secretary of State about drawing a random alphabet to determine order of candidates on the ballot for offices.
E-83 June 8	Candidates / District / Registrar of Voters	<i>EXTENSION OF NOMINATION PERIOD 10516</i> If a declaration of candidacy for an incumbent member of a special district is not filed by 5:00 p.m. on the 88th day before the election, any person other than the incumbent, shall have until 5:00 p.m. on the 83rd day before the election to file a declaration of candidacy for the elective office. The nomination extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected. If the extension is applicable, a candidate may withdraw his or her declaration of candidacy until 5:00 p.m. on the 83rd day before the election. <i>PUBLIC EXAM PERIOD (E.C. § 13313)</i> There will be a 10 day exam period for Candidate Statements filed. The period will be held <u>06/08</u> thru <u>06/17</u> .
E-83 June 8	District	<i>PUBLISH NOTICE OF POSSIBLE APPOINTMENT</i> If no one has been nominated to an office, prior to making an appointment to that office, a notice shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the district, stating that the board intends to make an appointment and informing persons of procedures for applying for the office.
E-83 June 8	Registrar of Voters	<i>INSUFFICIENT NOMINEES-POSSIBLE APPOINTMENT (E.C. § 10515)</i> If by 5:00p.m. on the 88 th day prior to the election there are insufficient nominees, the supervising authority shall make the appointment unless a petition is filed by this date to request that the election be held.
E-82 June 9	Candidates / Registrar of Voters	<i>WITHDRAW CANDIDATE STATEMENT (EXTENSION) (E.C. § 13307)</i> In the event there is an extension of the nomination period, candidates may have until this date to withdraw their candidate's statement. Withdrawal must be in writing
E-82 June 9	Secretary of State	<i>RANDOMIZED ALPHABET (E.C. § 13112)</i> On this date the Secretary of State shall conduct a drawing of the alphabet for determining the order of the candidate's names on the ballot.
E-29 – E-10 August 1 – August 20	Registrar of Voters	<i>BALLOT MAILING PERIOD (E.C. . § 4101)</i> Between these dates ballots will be mailed to district voters.
E-15 August 15	Voters	<i>CLOSE OF VOTER REGISTRATION (E.C. § 2107)</i> Last day to register to vote for the Rural North Vacaville Water District Election.

E-11 August 19	Registrar of Voters	NOTICE OF CENTRAL COUNTING PLACE (E.C. § 12109) The elections official shall publish a notice specifying the location in a newspaper of general circulation.
E-0 August 30	Registrar of Voters	<i>ELECTION DAY!</i> <i>Mail ballots much be received no later than 8:00pm .</i>
Dec. 2	Registrar of Voters	<i>Term Begins: (E.C. §10505)</i> Newly elected directors take office on this day. (1 st Friday in December)

Note: Provision due to holidays; if an election deadline falls on a holiday or weekend, then the act will be performed on the next working day. (E.C. § 15; G.C. §§ 6700, 6701)
