INFORMATION RELEASE SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO HOLD MULTI AGENCY TRAINING

09/17/13

The Solano County Sheriff's Office will be hosting 4 training sessions for law enforcement agencies throughout California. This training will be presented by the California Department of Justice and will be for law enforcement employees who are associated with entering data regarding persons required to register due to convictions of arson or sexual related crimes.

California law requires that persons convicted of certain arson or sexual related crimes register with their local law enforcement agencies annually. The training provided will be free of charge to the law enforcement personnel attending and will be presented in 4 hour sessions. There are currently four classes scheduled, 2 on September 25th and 2 on September 26th. The training will be specific to the entering of registrant's data into the California Sex and Arson Registry, (CSAR) system through various interfaces.

The Solano County Sheriff's Office continues its commitment to keep the community safe from convicted criminals that may be a threat to the community we serve. Continued monitoring of these offenders allows law enforcement throughout California to monitor their status within minutes.
