Welcome to my most recent update. I can be reached at mebrown@solanocounty.com.

I am sure many of you have heard that the first known case of monkeypox has been found in Solano County. This is very distressing news. Monkeypox, at this point, is extremely rare and there is a very low risk to the public overall at this time. My office has asked public health to reach out to communities disproportionately impacted by monkeypox to formulate the county's response.

Monkeypox cannot be spread by casual conversations or by walking by someone. It is spread by:

- Direct skin-skin contact with rash lesions
- Sexual/intimate contact, including kissing
- Living in a house and sharing a bed with someone
- Sharing towels or unwashed clothing
- Respiratory secretions through prolonged face-to-face interactions (the type that mainly happens when living with someone or caring for someone who has monkeypox)

The county will be receiving vaccines. My office requested that public health work with communities most impacted by monkeypox to formulate how to distribute them. Unfortunately, vaccine supply is extremely limited all over the country. I sent a letter to President Biden requesting more vaccines.

This is an evolving situation and guidance and information may change as we learn more about the current spread of monkeypox. For more information:

I-80 Six Bridges Project:

I-80 Overnight Highway Closure Between I-780 and State Route 37 in Vallejo:

EB I-80 Thursday, July 21, 2022 from 11:59 PM to 5:00 AM

WB I-80 Friday, July 22, 2022 from 11:59 PM to 5:00 AM

Caltrans has scheduled a **full overnight closure of eastbound** Interstate 80 in Vallejo on Thursday, July 21, 2022 from 11:59 PM until 5:00 AM on Friday, July 22, 2022, and a **full overnight closure of westbound** Interstate 80 in Vallejo on Friday, July 22, 2022 from 11:59 PM until 5:00 AM Saturday, July 23, crews will be working on lowering the bridge spans on Redwood Street overcrossing.

I-80 will be completely closed in one direction at a time for two consecutive nights as crews work on Redwood Street overcrossing. A detour will be in place.
