Search Warrant Service Leads to Drugs and Firearms Seizures
Solano County Sheriff's Office

September 9, 2009

A month long undercover investigation ended Wednesday afternoon with the arrest of a 32-year old resident of Vallejo. Dennis Pearson was contacted on a traffic stop in the Safeway market parking lot off of Admiral Callaghan Lane in Vallejo. Members from the Solano County Sheriff's Office Cal-MMET (California Multi-Jurisdictional Methamphetamine Enforcement Team) Unit and Sol-NET (Solano County Narcotics Enforcement Team) Unit, along with Vallejo Police Department's Crime Suppression Unit, arrested Pearson at the scene for his involvement with two previous ecstasy transactions to an undercover detective. After being arrested, officers seized 1,038 ecstasy pills and a loaded firearm from Pearson's vehicle.

A search warrant was later served at Pearson's apartment, which is located on the 2900 block of Redwood Parkway in Vallejo. Deputies seized an additional 60 ecstasy pills, packaging used in the sale of ecstasy and three firearms. An unidentified juvenile was also found in the home who was later turned over to Child Protective Services. The total estimated street value of the ecstasy seized from both locations was \$10,980.00.

Pearson was arrested for three counts of furnishing a controlled substance, three counts of possession for sales of a controlled substance, armed while committing a felony, armed while in possession of a controlled substance for sales and child endangerment. Pearson was booked into the Solano County Jail for the indicated criminal violations.
