BICYCLE EVENT ASSEMBLY PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The permittee shall post signs along the route of the event informing the public about the event and the date, time and duration of road closures. The permittee shall submit a map showing the proposed sign locations to the Solano County Department of Resource Management – Public Works Engineering thirty days in advance of the event for approval. All signs shall be posted a minimum of two weeks prior to the event. The permittee shall ensure all signs are placed in a safe location, and shall coordinate the installation with the affected utility companies to ensure the signs do not damage any underground facilities. All signs shall be removed within three days after the event has taken place.
2. The permittee shall provide traffic control at all intersections along the route of the event. Traffic control shall be performed by qualified marshals whom have received appropriate training from the California Highway Patrol (CHP) or local law enforcement agencies. The permittee shall arrange for traffic control to be performed by the CHP.
3. The permittee shall minimize the depositing of trash, including water bottles and cups, along the route of the event. The permittee is responsible for removing all trash and other debris deposited along the route as a result of the event within 24 hours after completion of the event.
4. The permittee shall conduct the event such that emergency vehicles shall not be restricted at any time.
5. The permittee shall obey all orders of law enforcement agencies during the event.
6. The permittee shall provide evidence of insurance coverage for this event in the minimum amount of \$5,000,000. All other standard insurance requirements shall apply.
7. The permittee shall require all participants in the event to hold Solano County and its officers, agents and employees harmless from any and all claims and/or liability for injuries or damages to persons or property arising from their participation in the event.
8. The permittee shall follow the traffic control and sign plan as submitted and approved for the event.
9. The placement of pavement markings to adequately mark the event route is allowed. However, the markings shall be non-permanent chalk-based or “fade-away” paint; permanent paint is prohibited.
