a. 2014 Disposal-Facility-Based Characterization of Solid Waste in California

In 2014 CalRecycle completed two studies — one for materials still being disposed in California's landfills from all sources, and one focused on materials both disposed and diverted from the commercial sector, by specific business groups. These data are essential for solid waste management planning, assessment of waste diversion activities, market development for recovered materials, and charting progress toward climate impact goals for California and its local governments to achieve the 75% recycling goal.
