Special Absentee Voters' Ballot Applications

The first day the Registrar of Voters may process applications for special absentee voters' ballots. Any applications received by the Registrar of Voters prior to this day shall be kept and processed on or after this date.

Counties Mail Sample Ballots

Between these dates, the Registrar of Voters shall mail sample ballots to each registered voter. §§ 13303

Vote-by-Mail Voter Ballot Application

Between these dates, any registered voter may apply to the county elections official for a vote-by-mail voter's ballot. Applications received before May 9, 2011 (E-29) shall be kept and processed during this application period. §§ 3001, 3003

May 17, 2011
(E-21)

This is the last day for the Registrar of Voters to mail sample ballots to the voters. § 13303

May 23, 2011
(E-15)

Registration Closes for the June 7, 2011, Rio Vista Special Election

The last day for any person to register to vote in the Rio Vista Special Election. §§2102, 2107

The affidavit shall be mailed or delivered to the county elections official and shall set forth all of the facts required to be shown by this chapter. A properly executed registration shall be deemed effective upon receipt of the affidavit by the county elections official if any of the following apply:

- (1) The affidavit is postmarked on or before the 15th day prior to the election and received by mail by the county elections official.
- (2) The affidavit is submitted to the Department of Motor Vehicles or accepted by any other public agency designated as a voter registration agency pursuant to the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. Sec. 1973gg) on or before the 15th day prior to the election.
- (3) The affidavit is delivered to the county elections official by means other than those described in paragraphs (1) or (2) on or before the 15th day prior to the election.

New Residents and New Citizens Registration Period

Registration for new residents shall begin the 14th day prior to an election and end on the 7th day prior to election day. This registration must be executed in the Registrar of Voters office, and the new resident shall vote a new resident's ballot in that office. §§ 332, 3400
A new citizen registering to vote after the close of registration shall provide the Registrar of Voters with proof of citizenship prior to voting and shall declare that he or she has established residency in California. §§ 331, 3500, 3501

The Registrar of Voters office shall receive and canvass the ballots of new residents and new citizens at the same time and under the same procedure as vote-by-mail voter ballots. §§ 3405, 3502

Computer Processing of Vote-by-Mail Ballots

The Registrar of Voters will begin to process their vote-by-mail voters' ballots on this date. Under **NO** circumstances shall a vote count be made before the close of the polls at 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Special Absentee Voter - Recalled to Military Service

A registered voter recalled to service after May 31, 2011 (E-7), but before 5:00 p.m. on June 6, 2011 (E-1), may appear before the county elections official and obtain a vote-by-mail voter's ballot which may be voted in the Registrar of Voter office or outside the Registrar of Voters office on or before the close of the polls and returned. § 3110

(E-6 - E-0)

Vote-by-Mail Ballots - Late Conditions

On or between these dates, any voter may apply in writing for a vote-by-mail voter's ballot if he or she will be unable to go to the polls on election day. The voter may designate any authorized representative to return the voted vote-by-mail voter's ballot. § 3021

June 7, 2011
(E-0)

Election Day, Polls open at 7a.m. and close at 8p.m.

June 9, 2011-
(E+2)

On this day the Registrar of Voters must begin the official (E+2) canvass of the precinct returns. §§ 15301, 15372

July 5, 2011
(E+28)

This canvass must be completed no later than July 5, 2011.
