<b>Categories for inclusion TBD – may include:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Role up into 14 potential health needs</li> <li>• Above/below benchmark</li> <li>• Health need score</li> </ul>	<b>Categories for inclusion TBD - may include:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Above/below benchmark</li> <li>• Confirmed by more than one source of secondary and/or primary data</li> <li>• Meets the definition of a “health need”</li> <li>• Significant health disparities (place or population-based)</li> </ul>	<b>Categories for inclusion TBD - may include:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identified consistently as one of the top three health needs by key informants/focus group members</li> <li>• Emerges as a theme through NVivo analysis (e.g. receives a certain number of counts)</li> <li>• Confirmed by more than one source of secondary and/or primary data</li> <li>• Meets the definition of a “health need”</li> </ul>
