Re: People v. Jorge Ulloa Romo

On March 1, 2017, in Department 7 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable Tim P. Kam, the jury found the defendant, Jorge Ulloa Romo, guilty of Battery With Serious Battery Injury in violation of Penal Code section 243(d) and Assault by Means Likely to Produce Great Bodily Injury in violation of Penal Code section 245(a)(4). On July 22, 2013, the victim, accompanied by his wife, dropped off his sister-in-law at the house she shared with her boyfriend and the defendant's family. The defendant's brother-in-law previously worked with the victim, approached the victim in the street and attempted to instigate a fight. The victim resisted and a verbal argument ensued. The defendant appeared unexpectedly during the ensuing verbal exchange and punched the victim multiple times while he was seated in the passenger seat of his wife's vehicle. The victim sustained nasal and septal fractures as a result of the strikes. The defendant is scheduled to be sentenced on April 10, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 7.



Officer Peppino Messina of the Vallejo Police Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Helenaz Solari.
