Re: People v. Marissa Stouffer

Today, in Department 4 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable Judge E. Bradley Nelson, the jury found the defendant, Marissa Stouffer, guilty of possession of a forged check in violation of Penal Code Section 475(a). On February 13, 2016, the defendant went to the California Check Cashing store in Vacaville. She presented a check from the City of Oakland in the amount of \$1348.17. The cashier asked the defendant why she had a check from the city and the defendant said it was from a new job. The cashier cashed the check. California Check Cashing later discovered that the check was fraudulent. Employees from the City of Oakland verified that the check was fraudulent and the defendant has never been employed by the city. She is scheduled to be sentenced on July 20, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 4.



Officer Michael Brennan of the Vacaville Police Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Kevin Cunnane.
