Re: People v. Chase Talon Wiley

During the evening of November 14, 2017, deputies from the Solano County Sheriff's Department were conducting a felony probation compliance check in the city of Benicia. It is alleged that the probationer, Chase Talon Wiley, 25, armed himself with an assault rifle and fired at the deputies. The defendant has been charged in a complaint with the following felony violations:

- Count 1: Attempted Murder of Peace Officer, Penal Code section 664/187
- Count 2: Attempted Murder of Peace Officer, Penal Code Section 664/187
- Count 3: Attempted Murder of Peace Officer, Penal Code Section 664/187
- Count 4: Attempted Murder of Peace Officer, Penal Code Section 664/187
- Count 5: Possession of Firearm by a Felon, Penal Code Section 29800
- Count 6: Unlawful Possession of Ammunition, Penal Code Section 30305
- Count 7: Possession of Destructive Device, Penal Code Section 18715
- Count 8: Possession of an Assault Weapon, Penal Code Section 30605
- Count 9: Unlawful Possession of a Large Capacity Magazine, Penal Code Section 32310
