

Agreement for Sponsorship to the Solano Vision & Impact Cohort Program Nonprofit Capacity Building

This agreement ("Agreement") sets forth our mutual understanding of the terms and conditions for the sponsorship by First 5 Solano Children and Families Commission, as a department of the County of Solano (collectively, "County"), and ______ ("Grantee").

Grantee agrees to participate in the Solano Vision & Impact Cohort Program, Nonprofit Capacity Building to be held from September 2019 to January 2020. The sponsorship is valued at \$10,000 per agency and is funded through a partnership between First 5 Solano Children and Families Commission and Solano County Health and Social Services.

(2nd optional "Staff Participant"), will attend all three sessions of the program, complete coursework prior to and between classes, engage in learning session conversation, and provide an update to First 5 Solano 6-months following completion of the course. Staff and Board Participant are material to this agreement and may not be substituted without prior written consent of First 5 Solano.

Grantee agrees to complete an outcome report six months following the conclusion of the program due no later than July 30, 2020. The report will capture progress during the program and in the six months following its conclusion. The report will include, but may not be limited to:

- Understanding of strategic planning and theory of change concepts
- Implementation of new agency policies
- Completion/update of an agency theory of change
- Change in organizational capacity to administer new strategies/plans
- New relationships with other Solano nonprofit leaders

Grantee's failure to complete the course, course work, or the outcome report may make the Grantee subject to consequences up to and including being considered ineligible for future funding.

County makes this grant with the parties' understanding that Grantee will indemnify, hold harmless and assume the defense of County, its officers, employees, agents and elective and appointive boards from all claims, losses, damages, including property damages, personal injury, death and liability of every kind, directly or indirectly, arising as a result of or in connection with Grantee's activities in connection with this Agreement.

The parties further understand and agree that Grantee: (1) shall maintain and enforce a drug free workplace¹; and (2) shall abide by all health and safety standards set forth by the State of

California and/or County pursuant to the Injury and Illness Prevention Program. The materials developed in conjunction with this course may not be for religious purposes, to benefit an individual or to promote a candidate for public office.

The laws of the State of California shall govern the validity, enforceability or interpretation of this Agreement. This Agreement, including any exhibits referenced, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior written or oral agreements between them concerning the subject matter contained in this Agreement. In the event any provision of this Agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate or render unenforceable any other provision of this Agreement.
