Questions June 10, 2020

1. How does it work if you are already accredited?

If you are already accredited for a specific Level of Triple P include this information in your proposal on Attachment B and include your certificate of accreditation with your proposal.

2. Does the Grantee organization need to have all staff and practitioners in place prior to submitting the grant?

It is not necessary to have all staff and practitioners in place prior to submitting a Proposal. In your proposal, you can describe the qualifications and the number of practitioners you intend to have to provide services. Optimally, potential practitioners should be available to attend the training cohorts beginning in late August for Level 2 and Level 3.

3. This budget is different, it is fee for service rather than line item. Can you talk about that a bit more?

In the resulting contract for successful proposers, the budget will be fee for service, which means agencies will be paid a specified amount for the completion of each specific service. This differs from a cost reimbursable contract where agencies bill actual expenses. As outlined in the RFP, common costs, such as practitioner salary, outreach, food, childcare, etc., have been factored into the reimbursement rate for each intervention.
