## Minutes For December 23, 2002

The Solano County Board of Supervisors met in special session on this day at 9:01 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Carroll followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence. All members were present.

## (Item 3) PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY, RATIFIED

Emergency Services Coordinator Bob Powell gave a brief update on the damage in the County noting there has been no loss of life, but there has been some loss of livestock.

This action is to acknowledge the local emergency and to prepare in case a State or Federal emergency is called. This proclamation will need to be reviewed every 21 days until the emergency is over, and will allow documentation of the damages under the Emergency Services Act.

Sheriff Gary Stanton noted there has been no final estimate of the cost of the damage that has been caused by the heavy rainfall and high winds.

Supervisor Kromm and Supervisor Thomson expressed concern relative to confusion on where people could get sand and sand bags.

There was a brief discussion regarding emergency phone system back and other emergency preparedness backup.

Supervisor Kromm expressed concern with not being able to get assistance to address a flooding problem off Suisun Creek.

On motion of Supervisor Kromm and seconded by Supervisor Thomson, the Board acted to ratify the Proclamation of Local Emergency declared December 20,2002. So ordered by a vote of 5-0.
