

ORDINANCE NO. 1527

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7.1
OF THE SOLANO COUNTY CODE ENTITLED
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, BY AMENDING SECTIONS
7.1-12 AND 7.1-13 TO DESIGNATE THE SOLANO COUNTY
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES COOPERATIVE AS THE
SOLANO COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AGENCY

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Solano, State of California, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

Sections 7.1-12 through 7.1-13 of the Solano County Code, are amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7.1-12. Local Emergency Medical Services Agency.

The Solano County Emergency Medical Services Cooperative, a Joint Powers Agency is designated as the local Emergency Medical Services (EMS) agency for Solano County. The medical director of the Solano County Emergency Medical Services Agency shall be the County Health Officer.

Sec. 7.1-13. Emergency Medical Services Regulations
and Requirements.

The Medical Director (or designee) of the Solano County Emergency Medical Services Agency shall adopt regulations and requirements as required by California statutes and regulations providing for:

(a) Terms of written agreements between the Solano County Emergency Medical Services Agency and cities, fire districts, and all other public safety and/or private organizations in the provision of prehospital emergency medical services.

(b) Approval and ratification by the Solano County Emergency Medical Services Agency, of an EMS system developed for Solano County meeting the requirements of applicable statutes and regulations.

(c) Terms of written agreements between the Solano County Emergency Medical Services Agency and approved emergency medical technician--paramedic (EMT-P) service providers concerning participation in the advanced life support system and compliance with applicable State regulations and local policies and

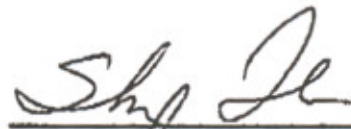
procedures.

(d) Performance standards, requirements, definitions of terms, the issuance and revocation of operating permits and the collection of fees therefor, the monitoring of Emergency Medical Services, creation and monitoring of exclusive operating zones for Emergency Medical Services ambulance providers, centralized Emergency Medical Services dispatch, imposition of civil and administrative penalties, and all other matters permitted or required by statute or regulation.

SECTION II.

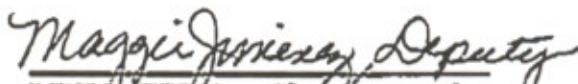
Pursuant to provisions of Government Code Section 25124 (b) (1), a Summary of this Ordinance shall be published once, at least FIVE (5) DAYS prior to the meeting of the Board of Supervisors at which the Ordinance is to be finally considered for adoption (second reading), and a summary of this Ordinance, with the vote of the members of the Board of Supervisors thereon, shall also be published once before the expiration of FIFTEEN (15) DAYS after adoption of the Ordinance. Both publications shall be in the DAILY REPUBLIC, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Solano, State of California, and the Ordinance shall be in full force and effect THIRTY (30) DAYS after its passage.

A certified copy of the full text of the proposed ordinance shall be posted in the office of the Clerk to the Board of Supervisors at least FIVE (5) DAYS prior to the meeting of the Board of Supervisors, at which the Ordinance is to be finally considered for adoption (second reading). A certified copy of the final Ordinance shall be posted in the Office of the Clerk to the Board of Supervisors, at least FIFTEEN (15) DAYS after adoption of the ordinance, and the posting shall include the vote of the Supervisors for or against the Ordinance.
