ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVALS

1. Request for a one year extension to exercise Minor Use Permit Application No. MU-14-03 of Verizon Wireless (c/o NSA Wireless) to construct a wireless communication facility atop an existing 97.9 foot tall PG&E lattice tower. The Verizon site would consist of six panel antenna mounted on a 12 foot tall "top hat" tower extension. Equipment cabinets would be located within the base of the existing tower on a raised steel platform with redwood enclosure fencing. The project is located at Gates Canyon and Vaca Valley Roads, Vacaville, in an "A-40" Exclusive Agricultural Zoning District, APN: 0121-150-100. (Project Planner: Eric Wilberg)

2. PUBLIC HEARING to consider Minor Use Permit Application No. MU-16-01 of Charles and Sharon King to permit residential accessory structure square footage exceeding 2,500 sq. ft. The property is located at 402 Vine Street, Vacaville, in an "RR-2.5" Rural Residential Zoning District, APN: 0129-010-150. The project qualifies for a Class I Categorical Exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15303, Small Structures. (Project Planner: Eric Wilberg) Staff Recommendation: Approval

After a brief presentation of staff's written report, Mike Yankovich opened the public hearing. The applicant concurred with staff's recommendation for approval.
