Test Description	Real-time reverse transcriptase polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) for the detection of a target polyprotein gene sequence in the Zika virus genome.
Acceptable specimens	 Serum at a volume of 2 mL (5 to 10 mL of blood) in a red top or serum separator tube without anticoagulant Urine at a volume of 10 to 15 mL in a sterile, leak-proof container
Timing of specimen collection	Serum should be collected within 14 days of illness onset or last date of exposure; urine should be collected within 21 days of illness onset or last date of exposure.
Specimen storage	Specimens should be kept refrigerated at 2–8°C for up to 72 hours after collection, and frozen thereafter (repeated freezing and thawing is not acceptable).
Specimen shipping	Specimens should be shipped refrigerated (2–8°C) and received by the laboratory within 72 hours of collection; frozen specimens should be shipped on dry ice.

Result availability (turnaround time)	Results are typically available within 2–3 weeks after specimen receipt.
