Test Description	InBios ZIKV Detect™ IgM Capture enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA) for the presumptive detection of Zika virus IgM antibodies in human sera collected from individuals meeting appropriate clinical or epidemiologic criteria.
Acceptable specimens	Serum in a red top or serum separator tube without anticoagulant
	Note: A volume of at least 1 mL of serum (~3 to 5 mL of whole blood) is preferred.
Timing of specimen collection	Serum should be collected between 4 days and 12 weeks of illness onset or last date of exposure.
Specimen storage	Serum should be kept refrigerated at 2–8°C for up to 48 hours. If the separated serum is to be stored beyond 48 hours, serum should be frozen at or below -20°C (repeated freezing and thawing is not acceptable).
Specimen shipping	Serum specimens should be shipped refrigerated (2–8°C); frozen serum specimens should be shipped on dry ice.
