READ ON TO SEE HOW YOU CAN GET CARE:

- If you have no Medi-Cal or Insurance you can still get prenatal care.
- If you are undocumented you can still get prenatal care.
- If your Medi-Cal is pending you do not have to wait to get care.
- If you have a Medi-Cal card you can go to a doctor right away.
