Arrests Made in Green Valley Burglary Cases

Arrests have been made stemming from the investigation of several residential and auto burglaries that occurred in the Green Valley area since the beginning of June.

Deputies received information from the Suisun Police Department who had arrested Antone Browning, an 18-year-old Fairfield resident for being in possession of stolen property that had been taken from one of the Green Valley burglaries. Browning was arrested by deputies on June 19th for burglary and conspiracy to commit burglary in cases being investigated by the Sheriff's Office.

Julius Hunter Lowery, an 18-year-old Woodland resident was arrested by deputies on June 20th after they developed leads connecting Lowery to the Green Valley burglaries. He was also charged with burglary and conspiracy to commit burglary. Both suspects were booked into the Solano County Jail on the indicated charges. The Green Valley burglaries remain under investigation. Deputies are working with investigators from the Fairfield Police Department and the Suisun City Police Department who are investigating similar crimes in their jurisdictions.
