In any case where the conditions of a use permit have not been or are not substantially complied with, or where the use has been abandoned, the Solano County Zoning Administrator may initiate permit revocation proceedings.

The Zoning Administrator alleges that the conditions of Minor Use Permit MU-13-01 have not been or are not being complied with, and proposes to revoke the permit. The request will be considered by the Solano County Planning Commission at 7:00 p.m. on August 15, 2013 or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, in the Board of Supervisors' Chambers, located at 675 Texas Street, 1st floor, Fairfield, California.

Specifically, the Zoning Administrator alleges that the special event facility is being operated in non-compliance with Minor Use Permit MU-13-01. Documentation has been submitted to the Zoning Administrator which indicates that an event has exceeded the maximum number of attendees. In addition, claims have been made that noise levels have exceeded permitted thresholds.

At the hearing, staff will outline the grounds for revocation listed above. You (as the permittee) will be given the opportunity to respond to any evidence or testimony presented by the Zoning Administrator, staff, or the public. Members of the public will also be afforded the opportunity to present their concerns.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the Planning Commission may (1) revoke the permit, (2) leave the permit in effect, or (3) modify the permit.

You may appeal any decision of the Planning Commission to the Board of Supervisors. An appeal must be filed within ten (10) days after the Commission announces its decision.

If your permit is revoked and you fail to remove the operation from your property, legal action may be brought against you. If the County initiates legal action to enforce zoning regulations on your property, notice may be recorded against your property pursuant to Section 65908 of the Government Code.
