Re: People v. Daryl Theron Crockett

On April 11, 2017, in Department 2 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable Daniel J. Healy, the jury found the defendant, Daryl Theron Crockett, guilty of cruelty to an animal in violation of Penal Code Section 597(a), a felony. On October 2, 2015, the defendant used a slingshot to shoot a metal ball bearing at his neighbor's maltipoo dog, Tippy. Tippy permanently lost his left eye as a result. The defendant is scheduled to be sentenced on May 17, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

Deputy Ronnie Sefried and Animal Control Officer Angela Gatto of the Solano County Sheriff's Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Melissa Ignacio. Shamar Lewis was the victim advocate.
