Re: People v. Jesus Camarillo

Today, after a three week jury trial, before the Honorable E. Bradley Nelson presiding, the jury found the defendant, Jesus Camarillo, Guilty of Second Degree Murder and found true that defendant used a firearm in the commission of that Murder in violation of Penal Code Section 12022.53 and Guilty of Attempted Murder and found true that defendant used a firearm in the commission of that Attempted Murder in violation of Penal Code Section 12022.53.

On December 10, 2016, Victim E.R. got into an altercation with one of the defendant's friends. The defendant's group left and retrieved a firearm. Later in the evening, Victim S.R. and Victim E.R. got into a verbal altercation with the defendant and his friends. Both sides agreed to fight. As Victim S.R. approached the defendant's group, the defendant pulled out a firearm and fired three shots at Victim S.R., striking him in the back of the body. The defendant then chased after Victim E.R. and fired several shots at him but not injured. Victim S.R. succumbed to his injuries.

After the verdict, the Honorable E. Bradley Nelson ordered the defendant remanded into custody and set a judgment and sentencing hearing for August 31, 2018, in Dept. 4.

Detective Sean Timm of the Fairfield Police Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Mary Nguyen. Janik Ferreira-Ward was the victim witness advocate.
