Discussion re Solano County Strategic Planning

Chairwoman Kondylis gave a brief introduction to the retreat and opening comments. Marilyn Snider, Facilitator, Snider and Associates, began conducting this goal setting review session by reviewing the agenda for the workshop, incorporated herein by reference. Marilyn Snider followed with addressing each item listed with the participation and cooperation of all participants of the workshop.

The Board discussed the Three-year Key Performance Measures to 1) improve the lives of children and their families; 2) promote agriculture and support responsible land use and economic development; 3)maintain a safe community; 4) improve the health and well-being of those who live and work here; 5)invest resources in and for the future; 6) increase organizational effectiveness, efficiency and communication; and brainstormed goals.

Closing comments were made with next steps which included the distribution of the retreat record, incorporated herein by reference, and direction for the Board of Supervisors to consider scheduling a Strategic Planning follow-up meeting in six months with Marilyn Snider, Snider and Associates for October 31, 2005 at a location to be determined.
