

## **Paramedic Preceptor Designation/Redesignation** **Frequently Asked Questions**

You must be a Solano County Accredited Paramedic to be eligible for Tier I or II Paramedic Preceptor Designation. Paramedic Preceptor Designation runs concurrent with your Solano County Paramedic Accreditation.

### **Initial Tier I Paramedic Preceptor Designation**

To be considered for designation as a Tier I Paramedic Preceptor, please submit the following:

- A Paramedic Preceptor Designation application. This can be found on the EMS Agency website under "FORMS."
- Copy of current Solano County Paramedic Accreditation card
- Verification of at least two (2) years of experience as a Paramedic in Solano County
- Copy of course completion certificate of a Preceptor Training Workshop within the last three (3) months
- Letter of recommendation from BOTH your employer and ALS Provider Medical Director

### **Initial Tier II Paramedic Preceptor Designation**

To be considered for designation as a Tier II Paramedic Preceptor, please submit the following:

- A Paramedic Preceptor Designation application. This can be found on the EMS Agency website under "FORMS."
- Copy of current Solano County Paramedic Accreditation card
- Verification of at least two (2) years of experience as a Paramedic in Solano County
- Copy of course completion certificate of a Preceptor Training Workshop within the last three (3) months
- Letter of recommendation from BOTH your employer and ALS Provider Medical Director
- Copy of proof of completion of formal training in education or adult education **OR** a provider-based training program focused on the topics of precepting a Paramedic student intern and instruction techniques of adult education

Any Tier I Paramedic Preceptor wishing to apply for Tier II status will only need to submit the proof of completion of formal training in education or adult education or a provider-based training program focused on the topics of precepting a Paramedic student intern and instruction techniques of adult education.

## **Tier I and II Paramedic Preceptor Redesignation**

To renew your Paramedic Preceptor Designation, you will need to submit the following:

- Paramedic Preceptor Designation renewal application when filing for Paramedic Reaccreditation

On the application, please list the names of the Paramedics you have precepted during the last accreditation cycle or any EMS related courses you have instructed. If you have not done either of these in the last accreditation cycle, submit proof of completion of a Preceptor Training Workshop within the last accreditation cycle.

If you do not file a Paramedic Preceptor renewal application at the time of Paramedic reaccreditation, or do not meet the requirements, your Paramedic Preceptor designation will be forfeited and you will need to reapply for initial designation at a later time.
