Saturday May 15th is Armed Forces Day. The military has an important history in Solano County and continues to be an integral part of our county. Thank you to all of those who have served our country in uniform.

SOLANO COUNTY COVID NUMBERS AND VACCINES

Solano's COVID numbers are still too high. Our numbers have kept us from moving out of the red tier. The largest driver of our numbers in Solano County are younger, unvaccinated people gathering and spreading the disease. The best way to get our numbers down and get out of the red tier is to get our residents vaccinated.

There are a lot of opportunities to get vaccinated in Solano County. You can go to most local pharmacies to get vaccinated. The fairgrounds will continue to provide second doses through May. While the second doses are offered, those who have not received their vaccination will have the opportunity to get the single dose J&J vaccine. There will also be more community vaccination clinics throughout the county.
