COVID NUMBERS AND VACCINES

As you probably heard, Solano County has reached the orange tier. While this is good news, our numbers are not where we would like them. We have a 10% positivity rate in Solano County. This is far too high and indicates that, at least among those who have not been vaccinated, the virus is still spreading. The tier system will go away completely on June 15th when the state reopens.

CALTRANS ANNOUNCEMENT

Solano County – Caltrans has scheduled a **full overnight closure of westbound** Interstate 80 in Vallejo on Wednesday, June 9, 2021 from 11:00 PM until 4:00 AM on Thursday, June 10, and a **full overnight closure of eastbound** Interstate 80 in Vallejo on Thursday, June 10, 2021 from 11:59 PM until 5:00 AM Friday, June 11 as crews will begin increasing the vertical clearance on Magazine Street Overcrossing.

I-80 will be completely closed in one direction at a time for two consecutive nights to increase the bridge spans on Magazine Street Overcrossing. A detour will be in place. During the I-80 closure times, eastbound or westbound I-80 onramps in Vallejo will be closed as needed to facilitate the work safely. Detour signs will be posted.

WB/EB I-80 Detours:

Motorists traveling westbound on I-80 will need to access I-780 to State Route 29 (Sonoma Blvd.) to WB I-80. Motorists traveling eastbound on I-80 will need to take State Route 29 (Sonoma Blvd) to I-780 to EB I-80.
