Groundwater Sustainability Plan Update

Background of the Groundwater Sustainability Plan

The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) of 2014, requires local jurisdictions and water agencies that overlie groundwater basins designated as high or medium priority by the State to form Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs). The GSAs are then responsible for developing a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) to manage their groundwater resources. Locally, the Solano Subbasin, which is identified as a medium priority basin by the State, has five GSAs within its boundary. These GSAs are the Solano Subbasin GSA, (of which Solano County is a member), City of Vacaville GSA, Sacramento County GSA, Solano Irrigation District GSA, and the Northern Delta GSA (see attached map). Together, these five GSAs also formed the Solano Subbasin GSA Collaborative (Solano Collaborative) for the purpose of having an open, transparent, and stakeholder-driven process to develop and implement a single GSP to manage the water resources in the subbasin. The Solano County Water Agency (SCWA) serves as the coordinator for the Solano Collaborative.

Once developed the GSP will provide an overall assessment of the groundwater conditions in the Solano Subbasin and provide methods to achieve and measure sustainability goals over a 20-year horizon. The GSP for the Solano Subbasin must be submitted to the California Department of Water Resources by January 31, 2022 and requires annual reviews and five-year updates through 2042. Groundwater Sustainability Plan Update

Since 2017, members of the Solano Collaborative have been engaging stakeholders and interested parties in the development of Solano Subbasin GSP. 
