CORONAVIRUS

While we have seen improvement from the summer surge, Solano’s COVID-19 numbers are still far too high. The virus is still very much present in our community and is still causing harm. The vaccines are providing protection. From the most recent data, 78% of those testing positive in Solano County are unvaccinated.

I continue to urge everyone to get vaccinated. Getting vaccinated protects you, protects your family, protects your community, protects our businesses, protects everyone. Please get vaccinated if you have not already and please encourage everyone you know to get vaccinated.

The county is holding mass vaccination events at the Solano Fairgrounds in Vallejo. You can get your first shot, second shot, or your booster shot there. As of right now, only Pfizer is available for a booster for eligible populations. If you are eligible for a booster, please get your booster. It will provide you with added protection.

Moderna and J&J have been recommended for boosters by the Food and Drug Administration’s advisory committee. When those are approved, they will be available at the booster clinics and at local pharmacies and hospitals.

You also can get a free ride to get your booster if you do not have transportation. If you are homebound, the county has a program where you can arrange to get your booster shot at home. You can obtain more information by calling 707-784-
