CORONAVIRUS

The Pfizer vaccine is now available to children age 5-11. Children in this age group will be able to get their vaccines at the mass vaccination clinic at the Fairgrounds in Vallejo. The clinic will run from Wednesday to Saturday at 9am-4pm. November 10th is the first day the 5-11 age group will be able to receive vaccines at the Fairgrounds. The county is working with school districts to hold vaccine events at schools.

The retail chain pharmacies will also soon start offering the vaccine to 5-11 age children. Even if you cannot find an appointment right away, keep looking at their websites as it may take a day or so to start offering the 5-11 option.

Boosters are also available at the mass vaccination clinic. It is extremely important for you to get a booster if you are eligible. If you took the J&J vaccine and want to take another shot of J&J as your booster, J&J will be available at the Fairgrounds clinic. For J&J, you may also get Pfizer or Moderna as your second shot. This also applies to Modern and Pfizer. You may mix the vaccines if you so desire.

It is extremely important that we get our boosters and that our children get vaccinated. With the holidays coming up, we may face another surge in cases as (70) people move events indoors and people have holiday gatherings.

The county is looking for retired doctors, nurses, EMTs, pharmacists, and anyone else eligible to give shots to work at our clinics. If you are qualified to
