Note: For judicial offices, the declaration of the intention shall be filed in the duplicate in the office of the Registrar of Voters in which the candidate's nomination papers are required to be filed. The declaration shall be filed not more than 14 nor less than 5 days prior to the first day on which nomination papers may be presented for filing; however, if the incumbent of a judicial office fails to file a declaration of intention by the end of such period, persons other than the incumbent may file declarations of intention no later than the first day for filing nomination papers. No candidate for a judicial office shall be required to state his or her residential address on the declaration of intention. (Election Code Section 8023)

All Code section references are to the California Election Code unless stated otherwise.
