ADOPT-A-ROAD PROGRAM SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Work shall be conducted during daylight hours when visibility is at least one-half mile and the ground is not wet or muddy. No work shall be conducted on holiday weekends.
2. Roadside litter removal shall be done a minimum of once every three months.
3. Litter removal shall not take place within six feet of the traveled way while traffic is present, or on bridges.
4. Traffic control is prohibited by this permit except for those instances authorized by the County's representative. Traffic control devices, if used, will be provided by the County.
5. If weather or other adverse conditions cause a public hazard, work shall be immediately discontinued.
6. Personnel performing work under this permit shall wear personal protective equipment, including safety vests.
7. Permittee shall designate a spokesperson that shall represent the group. In addition, one adult supervisor shall be assigned for each five minors. No minor less than 12 years of age shall be allowed to participate.
8. Participant's personal vehicles shall be legally parked off the traveled way so as not to interfere with the free flow of traffic.
9. It is understood and agreed by the permittee that any work performed under this permit shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions of this permit and all attachments.
10. The permittee is responsible for all liability for injury to, or death of, any person, or damage to property which may occur through any act or omission of either the permittee or Solano County arising from the issuance of this permit. In the event any claim, suit or action is brought against Solano County, its officers, agents or employees, by reason of, or in connection with, any such act or omission, permittee shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Solano County, its officers, agents and employees from such claim, suit or action.
11. This permit may be cancelled by the County for non-conformance with permit provisions or failure to adhere to directions given by County's representative.

12. Permittee shall contact the Area Road Supervisor no less than one week prior to roadside work, in order to coordinate receipt of supplies and bag pickup.
13. Permittee shall abide by the Adopt-A-Road Program Safety Requirements (attached). Permittee shall ensure that all participants receive a copy of the Safety Requirements prior to each day of litter removal. Permittee shall ensure that all participants abide by all listed Safety Requirements.
