## **PUBLIC HEARINGS**

1. PUBLIC HEARING to consider Minor Revision No. 1 to Use Permit U-18-03 to increase the size of the permitted special events facility at Monroe Ranch located at 4400 Suisun Valley Road, two miles west of the City of Fairfield, within the Suisun Valley Agriculture "A-SV-20" Zoning District; APN's: 0027-020-030, 080, and 090. The Zoning Administrator will be considering an Addendum to a previously adopted Negative Declaration for the project, pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15164. (Project Planner: Eric Wilberg, 707-784-6765) Staff Recommendation: Approval

<u>Action</u>: The applicants, Gary and Ying Bacon, were present. Mr. Bacon indicated he received the staff report and is in agreement with the conditions of approval.
