# 2023 Wreath Project at Sacramento Valley National Cemetery

When the Sacramento Valley National Cemetery was first opened in 2006, it became a holiday tradition to place fresh wreaths at each gravesite by local volunteers.

Every year since, the tradition has grown from just 300 in 2006 to 32,500+ this year. Thankfully, the number of volunteers and generous donations to provide and place the wreaths or boughs has also grown over time. The mission, championed by Curtis & Susie Stocking, is to continue to ensure that every year each gravesite at the cemetery is recognized and honored during the holiday season.

Solano County is home to thousands of veterans who have served our nation so honorably and fought to preserve the freedoms we enjoy today.
