## 1. Call to Order and Roll Call

## 6. Staff Report

#### A. Attendance & Revenue Summary

Parks Manager Chris Drake reported that as of 2/29/2024, Parks revenues are sitting at 76% of the 2023/24 revenue goal (FY23/24 revenue goal is \$700,000).

## **B. Status Updates**

<u>Public Access:</u> Patwino Park is not yet open; it is not known at this time when the new park will open to the public. Discussion took place regarding the installation of infrastructure and other projects to be completed by Solano Land Trust in order to open the park to the public.

Chris Drake reported to the Commission that there were wet weather closures at Lynch Canyon on 1/21 and 1/22/2024; 2/2/2024 through 2/25/2024; and 3/2/2024.

<u>Projects and Initiatives:</u> Parks Manager Chris Drake reported that the environmental review process is still ongoing regarding the ARPA funded projects at Lake Solano park and Sandy Beach park.

Discussion took place on various small vegetation restoration projects taking place at Lake Solano park as well as Sandy Beach park and minor updates to park assets that were started prior to the LNU fire in 2020.

For public safety, the boat launch and dock at Sandy Beach park have been closed until the appropriate repairs can be made.

<u>FWPF Grant Fund Balance:</u> Parks Staff reported to the Commission the current balance of the Fish and Wildlife Grant Fund.
