
Trauma T-06 Massive Hemorrhage

BLS Treatment

Spinal Motion Restriction: Per Policy 6611
Stabilize Airway: Use adjuncts as needed
Bleeding Control: Direct pressure, wound
packing, and tourniquets as needed
Oxygen: Administer unless unable
Warming: Cover patient with blankets
Rapid Transport: Minimize on scene time



TXA (Tranexamic Acid)

INDICATIONS:

Adult patients (≥ 15yo) with blunt or penetrating traumatic injuries, within three (3) hours, and any of the following:

- Significant bleeding with SBP < 90
- Significant bleeding with HR > 120
- Uncontrolled bleeding despite direct pressure, wound packing, or tourniquet application

EXCLUSION CRITERIA:

- Isolated traumatic brain injury
- Shock not related to bleeding (Neurogenic, Cardiogenic, etc)
