

Behavioral Emergencies B-2 Child/Elder/Dependent Adult Abuse, Domestic Violence, and Sexual Assault

Provide emotional support to patient and any family/friends

Contact law enforcement

Stabilize airway

Oxygen PRN – titrate SpO₂ >95%

Treat any medical or trauma complaints using the appropriate protocol

For victims of sexual assault, discourage bathing, washing, urination/defecation, or changing clothes.

Encourage sexual assault victims to be transported the closest receiving hospital for evidence collection.

For child, elder, or dependent adult abuse, file the appropriate reports with the respective agencies as outlined in Policy 6190, Duty to Report Abuse.

ALS Treatment

Treat any medical or trauma complaints using the appropriate protocol

Consider cardiac monitor
Consider IV/IO access

Transport all victims of sexual assault to the closest SANE-SART receiving center.
