### **IN HOME SUPPORT SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

#### **DUTIES—REQUIREMENTS**

The purpose and function of the advisory board is to provide ongoing advice and recommendations regarding in-home supportive services to the Board of Supervisors, and fulfill the roles & responsibilities related to the delivery and administration of in-home support services.
