The opponents don't understand Measure L and ignore these FACTS:

- **Yes on L modernizes an outdated law.** Fairfield's business license tax was set 40 years ago. Businesses pay the same flat tax they paid in 1984. Measure L modernizes the tax to match service costs and streamlines compliance.
- **Yes on L protects small businesses.** The city recently cut expenses and services by more than \$5 million. Measure L protects small business from further cuts, like police and emergency medical response.
- **Yes on L ensures large businesses pay their fair share.** Businesses use city services just like residents and Measure L ensures large businesses pay their fair share for the local city streets, police, fire protection, and rapid emergency response they rely upon.
- **Yes on L DOES NOT increase taxes on residents.** Measure L only impacts businesses operating in Fairfield and does not increase taxes on residents by one dime.
- **Yes on L means local control for Fairfield.** Measure L gives Fairfield local control over local funds for local needs. Every penny stays in Fairfield and cannot be taken away.
- **Yes on L protects essential services in Fairfield.** Locally controlled funding will help repair potholes, maintain local streets, support fire protection, neighborhood police patrols, and rapid 9-1-1 emergency response.
- **Yes on L requires fiscal accountability.** Annual independent audits and public disclosure of all spending ensures that all funds are spent properly.

Vote Yes on L, and its companion Measure M, to maintain essential services in Fairfield without increasing taxes on residents.


