The photo above was taken at the Lookout Slough Levee Breaching event with the Department of Water Resources last month. The project is the single largest tidal wetland restoration project in the Delta to date, and it meets the objectives of the Central Valley Flood Protection Plan. The project creates habitat for native fish and wildlife, while also offering 100-year flood protection with its new setback levee.



Rio Vista Bridge Repair Closures Start Tonight



Make plans for the detours and travel delays during the Rio Vista Bridge scheduled closures that start this weekend.

The Rio Vista Bridge (Helen Madere Memorial Bridge) on State Route 12 will undergo multiple 55-hour closures this fall for a paving project by Caltrans District 3. Motorists should expect detours and may experience additional travel times of up to two hours.

The closure dates are:

- Friday, October 18th from 9:00pm to 5:00am Monday, October 21st
- Friday, November 1st from 9:00pm to 5:00am Monday, November 4th
- Friday, November 15th from 9:00pm to 5:00am Monday, November 18 (Tentative) All work is weather permitting.

The \$11.24 million project includes vital repairs and upgrades to enhance safety for all users, including ADA-compliant ramps for improved accessibility.
