## **Notice of Public Meeting for Discussion of Possible State CDBG Application**

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NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of Solano will conduct a public meeting on Tuesday, November 26, 2024 at 6:00 p.m., at the Solano County Events Center, 601 Texas Street, Fairfield, CA 94533 to discuss possible applications for funding under the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and to gather residents' ideas for possible activities to be included in the application.

The purpose of this hearing is to review CDBG eligible activities and collect residents' views on housing and community development needs (which includes services, facilities, and/or infrastructure that will improve livability within the community).
