This will result in 31 newly striped parking spaces for the online pickup program as well as 7 new trees and a new light standard in this area. The project includes an interior remodel as well as repainting of the store and refacing both the building and pylon signage.

REASONS WHY THIS PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000, et. seq. of the California Public Resources Code, hereafter CEQA) requires analysis of agency approvals of discretionary "projects." A "project," under CEQA, is defined as "the whole of an action, which has a potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment." The proposed action is a project under CEQA and is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15303 "New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures" in that the proposed project would be adding less than 2% to the existing building footprint.
