Countywide Programs:

Solano County Older Adults Medical Trip Concierge Service

- This program provides subsidized Uber/Lyft services for senior county residents to get to and from medical appointments (hospital, dentist, chiropractor, pharmacy, etc.).
- Veterans of any age can access Travis AFB, Martinez VA clinic, Hume Center, and the Med Evals/QTR Assessment Center in Concord.
- Fixed-income seniors can receive discounts between 60 and 80 percent.

Solano County Intercity Taxi Card Program
