CAL-MMET/SOL-NET TEAM MAKE DRUG ARRESTS Solano County Sheriff's Office

December 17, 2008

Three persons were arrested for various drug offenses and child endangerment following an execution of a search warrant. The Solano County Sheriff's Office Cal-MMET/Sol-NET unit (California Multi Jurisdictional Methamphetamine Enforcement Team-Solano Narcotics Enforcement Team) served the search warrant on the 100 block of Kenyon Drive in the City of Vacaville on Tuesday, December 16, 2008 at 7:30 in the morning. A young child was found in the home and was subsequently taken into the custody of Child Protective Services.

Once inside the residence law enforcement personnel discovered approximately two grams of Cocaine with an estimated street value of \$150.00, and five ounces of Marijuana with an estimated street value of \$1800.00. Also seized from the home were brass knuckles, ammunition, and an unsecured .22 caliber long rifle.

25-year-old Nicole Michelle Hill who rented the home was arrested for maintaining a home for sales and use of drugs, possession of a dangerous weapon, child endangerment and renting a room for sales of drugs. Hill was booked into the Solano County Jail and is being held on a \$34,999 bail. She is scheduled to be arraigned in the Solano County Superior Court on December 18, 2008.

19-year-old Timothy John Casavant who rented a room in the residence was also arrested for possession of cocaine, possession of marijuana, child endangerment and being armed in the commission of a felony. Casavant was booked into the Solano County Jail and is being held on a \$46,000 bail. He is scheduled to be arraigned in the Solano County Superior Court on December 18, 2008.

27-year-old Brandon Adrian Kendrick of Suisun, a visitor to the home was also arrested for being an ex-felon in possession of a firearm, ex-felon in possession of ammunition, possession of a dangerous weapon and probation violation. Kendrick was booked into the Solano County Jail and is being held without bail. He is scheduled for arraignment in the Solano County Superior Court on December 18, 2008.
