3100 Marijuana Plants Seized in Solano County
Solano County Sheriff's Office

July 23, 2009

On today's date, a multi-jurisdictional law enforcement effort led to the eradication of 3100 marijuana plants growing in the hills outside the city limits of Vacaville. Officers from the Solano County Narcotics Enforcement Team, California Multi-Jurisdictional Methamphetamine Enforcement Team, and C.A.M.P. (Campaign Against Marijuana Production), were air-lifted into the hills west of Vacaville where they eradicated two separate gardens, burning the seized marijuana afterwards.

This is the first of many missions scheduled during the marijuana growing season throughout Solano County. Trained observers locate the growing marijuana grows during routine aerial missions. They are plotted using G.P.S. coordinates, and later slated for seizure by law enforcement officers at a later date. Each seized plant has a potential street value of \$5,000. No arrests were made during the course of today's activities.
