Test	T-SPOT. TB Test
Test Description	The T-SPOT. TB test is an indirect, screening test for Mycobacterium tuberculosis infection that measures T cell response to Mycobacterium tuberculosis antigens. The T-SPOT. TB blood test does not cross-react with the BCG vaccine and it is appropriate to use in patients with immunocompromised status. Note: T-SPOT.TB specimens are referred to Oxford Diagnostics for testing.
Acceptable specimens	Whole blood collected in a single lithium or sodium heparin tube (required). Blood volume requirements are dependent on patient age: a. 0–2 years: 2 ml
	b. 2–9 years: 4 ml c. >9 years: 6 ml
Required information	Specimens cannot be tested unless the information below is provided: 1. Patient name 2. Patient identifier (e.g., medical record number) 3. Patient date of birth 4. Patient address 5. Date and time of collection 6. Physician name and NPI number
Specimen storage	Whole blood specimens must be stored at room temperature.
Specimen shipping	Whole blood specimens should be shipped at room temperature and must be received by the laboratory by 2 pm for same day processing. Advance notification is helpful. Note: Specimens cannot be received on the business day before a holiday.

Test fee	Refer to the posted fee schedule
Result availability (turnaround time)	T-SPOT. TB testing results are typically faxed to the submitter within 5 business days of specimen receipt.
