Project Title: McCoy Creek Trail Phase 3 Improvements Project

Project Location: This pedestrian/bicycle trail project is located along an east-west alignment on the north bank of the Laurel Creek from Blossom Avenue west to Sunset Avenue, as well as along a north-south alignment on the east bank of the Laurel Creek from Railroad Avenue south to the east-west alignment.



REASONS WHY THIS PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000, et. seq. of the California Public Resources Code, hereafter CEQA) requires analysis of agency approvals of discretionary "projects." A "project," under CEQA, is defined as "the whole of an action, which has a potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment." The proposed action is a project under CEQA, and is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 "Existing Facilities" and 15302 "Replacement and Reconstruction". The project is fully within public right of way and is for the minor alteration of a public maintenance road. The project will reconstruct an existing public facility where the new facility will be located on the same site as the facility replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the facility replaced. Moreover, the area in which the project is located is not environmentally sensitive.
