- Prop 47- was awarded Cohort 3 funding of 6,000,000 to run through June 2026.
- ARPA funds have been approved by the Board of Supervisors to fund 4 specific BH projects.
 - a. The Beck facility will be funded by both APRA and Prop 47 funds for the first two years.
 - i. Ribbon cutting ceremony will be held on October 25th @ 2pm and everyone is welcome.
 - BH Internship Program- Train 10 clinicians per year through this program.
 - The county is looking to update a Sequential Interception Model mapping update of the Opioid epidemic.
 - a. Benicia, Dixon, and possibly Vacaville are interested in partnering in this project.
 - b. The county is asking more cities to partner with them on this project.
