The foster child's health exam may include:

- ♦ Physical examination
- Health and developmental history
- ♦ Nutrition screening
- ♦ Vision and hearing screening
- Developmental and behavioral screening
- Immunizations
- Blood and urine tests
- ♦ Health and wellness education
- Oral health assessment and routine referral to a dentist for children over 12 months of age
- Referrals to specialists and community programs as needed

It is important to follow all the medical advice given to you by the health care provider.

Please take your child to all recommended follow up appointments.

Foster Care Physical and Dental Exams

Regular physical and dental exams are an important part of the care you give your foster child.

Often times, foster children have had little or no health care.

They may also have more health problems than other children.

Frequently, they have problems you cannot see.

These "well-child" check-ups are given at no cost to you because your foster child is in the Medi-Cal program.

A health problem found and treated at an early age is easier to correct, saves on medical costs, and may prevent serious problems in the future.

Frequent Exams Are Important.

All children entering foster care are required to have a physical exam and dental exam within 30 days of placement.

Periodic check-ups are then required at each of the following ages:

MEDICAL

INFANCY: newborn-9 months

- 1-5 days after birth
- By 1 month
- 2 months
- 4 months
- 6 months
- 9 months

EARLY CHILDHOOD: 12 months-4

years

- 12 months
- 15 months
- 18 months (1.5 years)
- 24 months (2 years)
- 30 months (2.5 years)
- 3 years
- 4 years

MIDDLE CHILDHOOD: 5 years-10

years

Every year

ADOLESCENCE: 11 years-21 years

• Every year

DENTAL

Dental Exams begin at age 1.

• Every 6 months, or earlier if a problem exists
